

AIRPORT FUEL STORAGE SYSTEM EXPANSION

NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS TUNICA MUNICIPAL AIRPORT

Sealed bids for AIRPORT FUEL STORAGE SYSTEM EXPANSION will be received by the TUNICA COUNTY AIRPORT COMMISSION (TCAC) at the Tunica Air Center, 209 South Airport Boulevard, Tunica Mississippi 38676, until 4:30 PM, Local Time on February 15, 2012, at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud. Bids received after this time will not be accepted and will be returned unopened.

The work is generally described as follows:

The "Work" of this Contract is to include, but is not limited to, providing all labor and materials for the AIRPORT FUEL STORAGE SYSTEM EXPANSION project at Tunica Municipal Airport. The scope of work generally consists of (but is not limited to): installation of one 20,000 gallon UL142 double-wall Jet A fuel storage tank, installation of one 300 gallon per minute Jet A fuel pumping skid system capable of future expansion to add an additional 300 gallon per minute pump, electrical connections, interconnecting of piping, connection to an existing fuel hydrant system and flushing of the existing fuel hydrant system.

A pre-bid conference will be held in the conference room, Tunica Air Center, Tunica Municipal Airport on February 1st at 11:00 a.m. local time.

Bidders must be qualified under Mississippi Law and show a current Certificate of Responsibility issued by the Mississippi Board of Public Contractors establishing classification as to the value and type of construction work on which he is authorized to bid.

The TCAC has established a disadvantage business enterprise (DBE) goal of 10% for DBE participation based on the amount of the MDOT Multi-Modal funds to be expended for the stated project, to be accomplished in whole or part, by this contract.

There is no cost for this electronic copy of the contract documents.

Bidders' attention is directed to the Instructions to Bidders relative to pre-award, equal employment opportunity requirements, and non-segregated facilities.

Bids must be submitted on the standard form of bid proposal and must include a Bid Bond in the amount of 5% of the Bid. The successful bidder will be required to execute the standard form of Contract and Agreement, together with a 100% Performance Bond and a 100% Payment Bond, within 3 days after formal award of the contract.

Each Bidder's attention is called to Section 31-3-21 of the Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended. This provides in part as follows: "When a nonresident contractor submits a bid for a public project, he shall attach thereto a copy of his resident state's current law pertaining to such state's treatment of nonresident contractors."

The bidder shall guarantee to hold his bid good and may not withdraw his bid for a period of 90 calendar days after the scheduled closing time for receiving bids.

The award, if made, will be made to the party submitting the bid deemed most favorable to the TUNICA MUNICIPAL AIRPORT COMMISSION at the time the conditions are stipulated. The TUNICA MUNICIPAL AIRPORT COMMISSION reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive any informalities or irregularities in the bids received.
